All applications are reviewed by the Medical Director for acceptance of children with the greatest need. Please keep in mind that <u>no children should be guaranteed that they are going to camp; they must apply and wait to be accepted.</u> Applications are available beginning in January through our partner organizations or through our website for The Painted Turtle, <u>www.thepaintedturtle.org</u>.

MEDICAL CRITERIA FOR ALL SESSIONS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Minimum developmental age of 5 years.
- Must be able to function and participate in a group setting.
- Must be able to communicate needs independently.
- Can be without family members for the duration of the camp session.
